This **\$5000** scholarship supports high-achieving students to apply their skills, learning and passion in an internship experience at the Human Services Campus (HSC) to advance the mission to end homelessness.

- Awards are for a full-time (one semester) or part-time (two semester) internship.
- Open to students across majors at ASU.
- Students will be supported as a cohort, and will have access to a range of learning opportunities including shadowing a variety of positions on the HSC.

Students will work on projects at the Human Services Campus that aim to **improve client outcomes**, by contributing to the **efficacy** of the HSC operations, advancing research and **innovative solutions to homelessness**, and working with us to make your unique contribution to ending homelessness in Arizona.

Project opportunities include, but are not limited to:

- Direct client services and assistance
- Assistance with data collection of client engagement, including conducting surveys and focus groups
- Outreach and engagement efforts

- This scholarship is for academically high-achieving students with excellent interpersonal skills and a passion for public service.
- Minimum 3.25 GPA (must be maintained while in receipt of the scholarship).
- Need-based.
- Academic level: upper-level undergraduates (third and fourth year) including transfer students, and graduate students.
- Demonstrated professional or volunteer experience aligned with HSC mission. (Preference will be given to students who have previously volunteered at the HSC.)
- Student skills and interests will be matched with HSC goals and current project needs.
