
### Statistics



55.4%

Of Native American female homicides are related to intimate partner violence<sup>3</sup>

40 – 50% of murdered women are killed by an IP or ex IP

2/3 to ¾ of women are abused before being a victim of IPH

When men are killed by women there has been prior IPV against the female in 75% of cases

Between 1980 and 2008 IP homicides for women increased 5%

 Homicides of men decreased 53% in the same period


